ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Oral sessions are held in Main Hall "SAKURA" on the second floor of Gotemba Kogen Hotel BU. Please submit your presentation data in a USB memory, CD-R, or your own laptop computer to the PC reception desk in the main hall 10-30 min before the beginning of your session. You are asked to preview your presentation on the computer screen, or with the projector in a case you bring your own computer.

The computers supplied by us are a PC with Windows Vista/PowerPoint 2007 and a Mac with OS 10.6/PowerPoint 2008. If your computer system does not suit them or your presentation contains movie or sound effect, please use your own computer.

Presentation time (including discussion) is 45 min for the opening and closing sessions and 30 min for the other sessions. Please leave appropriate discussion time.

POSTERS

Posters are displayed in the hall next to the Main Hall (second floor of Gotemba Kogen Hotel BU).

The size of a poster panel will be 120 cm (width) x 180 cm (height). Poster numbers will be displayed on the panels by the conference.

Posters should be set up before the oral session starts in the morning of Tuesday, June 15th and take down by the night of Thursday, June 17th.

Poster sessions are scheduled at19:30 - 21:00 of Tuesday, June 15th and Wednesday, June 16th. Drinks will be served during the poster sessions. The authors are requested to be present in front of their posters for discussion during the core time as below.

For odd poster numbers, 20:00 - 21:00 of Tuesday, June 15th.

For even poster numbers, 20:00 - 21:00 of Wednesday, June 16th.

Three to four posters will be selected for short presentations (5 min including discussion) in the poster presentation session held at 11:45 - 12:15 of Thursday, June 17th. Each poster presenter is asked to take electric presentation slides (up to 4) for the poster presentation.
